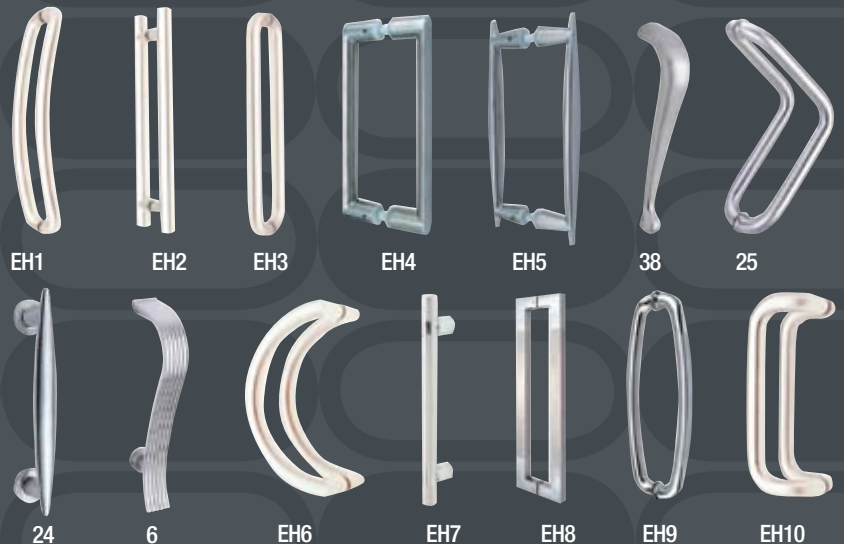
Select Your Timber
